


Year 6 Home Learning Tasks - Week beginning 8th June 2020

 - 2. Choose a phrase which shows that **they are not sure** how the boy fell from the boat.
 - 3. Name **3 places** they had already visited.
 - 4. Which word in the text is closest in meaning to **searching**? (Find a **synonym** for searching in the text.)
 - 5. Imagine the boy has been found. Write a statement as if you are the boy explaining what happened that night.

Maths Work out the perimeter (measurement all the way around the shape) and the area (length x width) of these shapes. Remember to write on all the missing measurements first and also split the shape into smaller sections to make it easier to work out the area.


3. What is the name of the punctuation around this speech?
