



Be like a tree!

Start your day off with a mindful stretch and balance. Imagine you're a tree and your feet are the strong roots connecting you to the ground. Take 3 deep breaths. Stretch your arms up into the air like branches reaching for the sky. Sway side to side as the wind blows you gently. Stop still with your hands together above your head. Slowly lift one foot and press it against the ankle of your other leg. Hold and count to 10. Repeat with the other foot and count on from 10 to 20. Place your foot down and bring your arms down by your side. Take 3 deep breaths.
