

Before Reading (Predict)

- What do you think the text will be about?
- What do you think will happen to the characters?
- Do you know anything about this author?

During Reading

Help your child to read accurately.

- Does that make sense? Sound the letters out.
- Skip over a word and come back to it. Find an alternative.
- Do the pictures provide any clues?
- Look for chunks of letters that you know.

Ask questions to help them understand.

- How do you think the character is feeling? Why?
- What does this word mean?

Make Connections

- Who does this character remind you of?
- Have you ever been to a similar setting?

Visualise

- Can you imagine the smell, sounds and sights from the book?
- Can you imagine how you'd feel if you were the character?

After Reading (Summarise)

- Did you like the text? Why?
- Can you retell the story?
- What was your favourite part?
- Would you recommend this text?

After Reading (Activities)

- Create a book in a box to show your family and friends what your book was about. Bring it into school to share with your teacher.
- Write a book review about your book:
 what was your favourite part, which parts
 did you not like so much, how many stars
 would you give it, who would you
 recommend it for?
- Choose your favourite moment in the book and illustrate the moment. What media are you going to use? Pencil crayons, shading pencils, paint?
- Record yourself reading the book aloud to your adult. You can bring this in to share with your teacher.
- Write down any new or unusual words you have come across and put them in your class' Wonderful Word Jar.
- Turn your book into a storyboard or comic strip. Remember to include all the important plot points.
