## Children's Mobile Phone Permission

Please note that your child will need to switch his/her phone off completely before entering the school grounds and will need to hand their phone in to a designated member of staff at the beginning of the school day. The school accepts no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged mobile phones that are brought to school.

All mobile phones should be turned off until the child has left the school grounds.

If your child doesn't follow these rules and misuses their phone, the school will withdraw permission for them to bring it.
