Late Stations



Attendance and punctuality are a big priority for us this year. Our hope is that all children will be OTIS but we understand that sometimes families will arrive to school late. To get children into school quicker and avoid any unnecessary delay, we have created Late Stations. Any child arriving between 8.50am and 9.15am must first register at the Late Station before entering the school building. For Nursery children, the Late Station is upstairs at the main office and for children in Reception to Y6, the Late Station is accessed by the side gate entrance at the bottom of Bankwood Close.

Ready to Learn

Attendance has been low since we've come back to school and we've noticed a lot of absences. Please support us with this by getting your child to school each day. If they are unwell, please phone school to let us know.

Our attendance target is **96%.**

We notice a huge difference in children's attitude to learning when they are in the classroom **on** time and ready to begin the daily learning activities. We'd like our **Ready to Learn** percent to be **100%**, meaning **every** child has arrived to school **on time**; not late.
