# Uniform Policy

As an ambassador of our school, pupils should be easily identified both in school and in the community as from Bankwood. To provide an appropriate image, all pupils are expected to wear complete school uniform throughout the school day and while travelling to and from school.

The school uniform expectations are as follows:

Navy blue jumper or cardigan

White or navy blue polo shirt

# Black or grey tailored trousers

Trousers must be tailored, straight legged and full length; Trousers must not be jeans, jeggings, leggings or tracksuit bottoms;

# Black or grey school dress or skirt

### Plain black footwear

All footwear must be plain black. Logos, tongues and any visible sole must be plain black Laces must be plain black

During the summer, pupils are also permitted to wear

### Blue gingham dress

#### Plain black or grey tailored shorts

Shorts must be tailored, straight legged and finish at or below the knee Shorts must not be jean material, jeggings, leggings or tracksuit materials

All school uniform items should be clearly labelled with the pupil's name.

Hairstyles and colour must be appropriate for school. Extreme colours and/or hairstyles for example unnatural colours or shaved lines and patterns, or any style that brings undue attention to the pupil (as determined by the school) are not permitted.

Hair accessories must be discreet and in school colours.

Headscarves worn for cultural reasons must be plain black

### Jewellery

For safety reasons, the only items of jewellery permitted are listed below:

- One pair of stud earrings worn with one earring in the lobe of each ear.
- A single stud earring worn in the lobe of an ear.
- An analogue watch.

Pupils are not permitted to wear any other items of jewellery. If a child does wear jewellery which is not permitted they will be expected to take it off.

No jewellery of any kind to be worn for P.E lessons. Any jewellery brought into school is the child's responsibility. School can take no responsibility for jewellery which is brought into school.

**Accessories** eg. Hats, caps, scarves, hooded jumpers etc. for outdoor use are not permitted in the classrooms and must be left in cloakrooms during lesson time.

**Mobile phones** and other electronic devices are not permitted in school. In Y5 and Y6, mobile phones can be handed in to the school office on arrival.

# Compliance with uniform requirements

It is expected that all pupils will wear full school uniform at all times. Exception notes from parents will not be accepted, as we will provide temporary loans if necessary.

If a pupil chooses not to follow all parts of the uniform requirements, the school will take the following action:

On the first refusal pupils will be asked to change into spare school uniform On the second, pupils will be asked to change and a letter will be sent to parents/carers
