

FS1 Home Learning Tasks - Week beginning Monday 6th July 2020

Reading

This week, we are reading Jack and the Beanstalk. If you don't have this book at home, then watch this video:

See if you can count to 3. What comes next? Keep going to see if you can count beyond 10. How far can you count? Challenge: Can you count up to 20 objects accurately?

Estimating is so important! Ask your adult to give you a small pile of objects (no more than 10). How many do you think there are? Now, count them to check if you were right. Keep practising this skill.

Using any Duplo, Lego or blocks that you have, can you create a tower like the one in Jack and the Beanstalk?

If you don't have anything you can use, you could draw/paint the beanstalk instead. You could even use some scissors to cut some real grass to add to your picture.

Can you think of some words that rhyme with Jack? Sack, back ...
