

As you read/watch, talk about what is happening in the story. Ask your child what they think might happen next.

Maths

Can you make a number track like the one below? Ask an adult to help you.



Chose a number on the number track by closing your eyes and pointing to a number. Open your eyes, say the number, then see if you can find that amount of twigs, stones or bugs outside. If not, can you find some objects inside? Can you place what you have found next to the correct number? Try again by choosing a different number.

Moving and Handling

Ask your adults if you can cut the grass using a pair of scissors to practise your cutting skills! Just like the Billy Goats Gruff eating it.

Talk about the length of the grass. Is it short or long? Count the grass strands and find this number on your number track.


Can you make a nature bug? Use the grass you cut, some mud, leaves, twigs or anything else you can find outside to make a creepy crawly bug.
