Please make sure you clear a space before doing</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Make your own homemade bubbles!</p> <p>Ingredients:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 4 cups of warm water ½ cup of sugar ½ cup of dish soap <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Whisk the sugar and water together until sugar dissolves. 2. Add the dish soap and whisk to combine. 3. Let it sit. The bubbles work better if you let it sit for a couple of hours.


Use your knowledge of clocks and telling the time to fill in the following clock faces:











Write the time that is **1 hour before** the time on each clock.
